
## Dive Against Debris®

Dive Against Debris<sup>®</sup> is a survey of underwater marine debris. Only report debris you find underwater while on SCUBA through Dive Against Debris<sup>®</sup>. Survey leaders should record all diver findings for the same individual survey dive, onto one Data Card.
