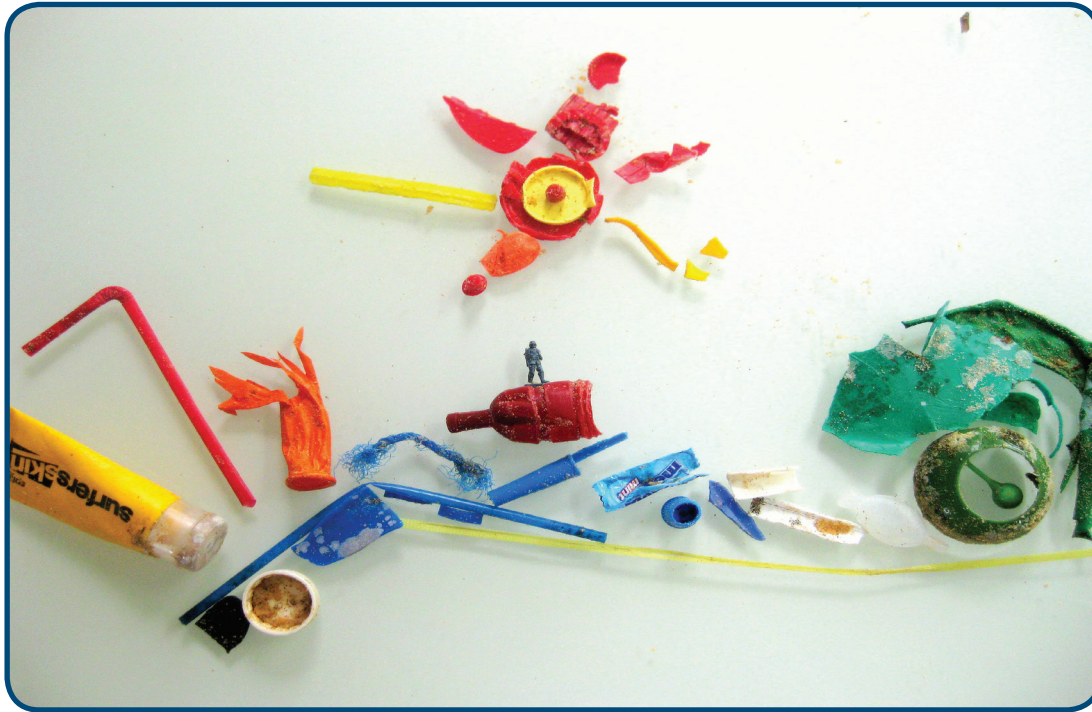


RUBBISH HUNT



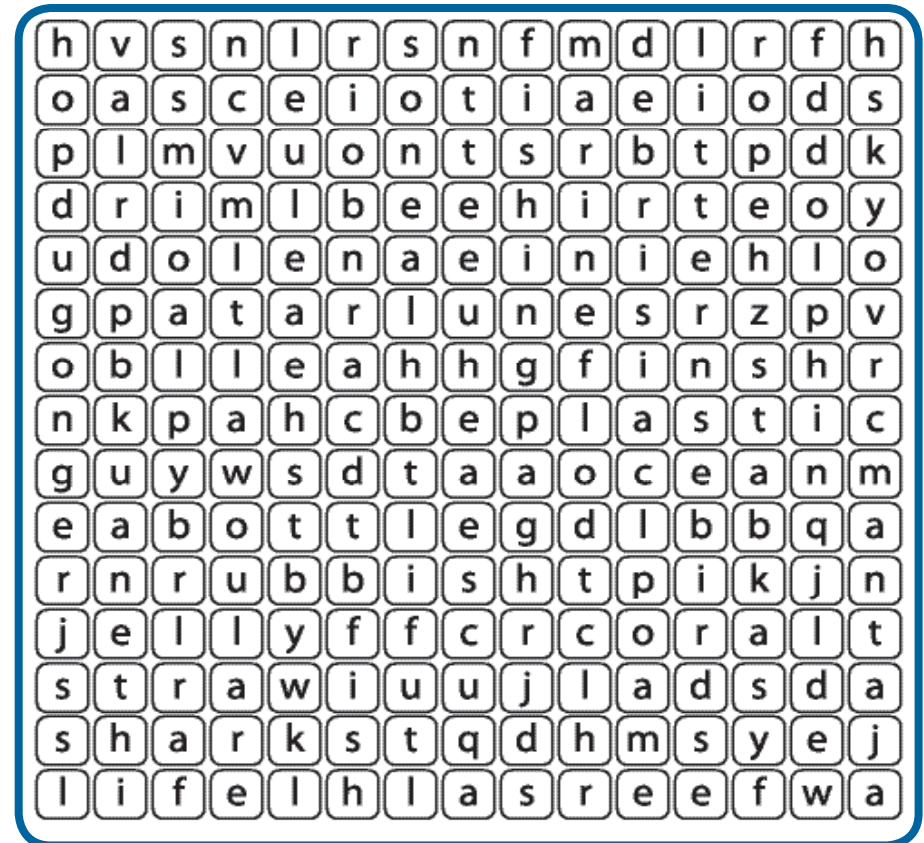
1. One beach, ten minutes - how many pieces of plastic can you see? Count the rubbish in the photo and write the number in the box.

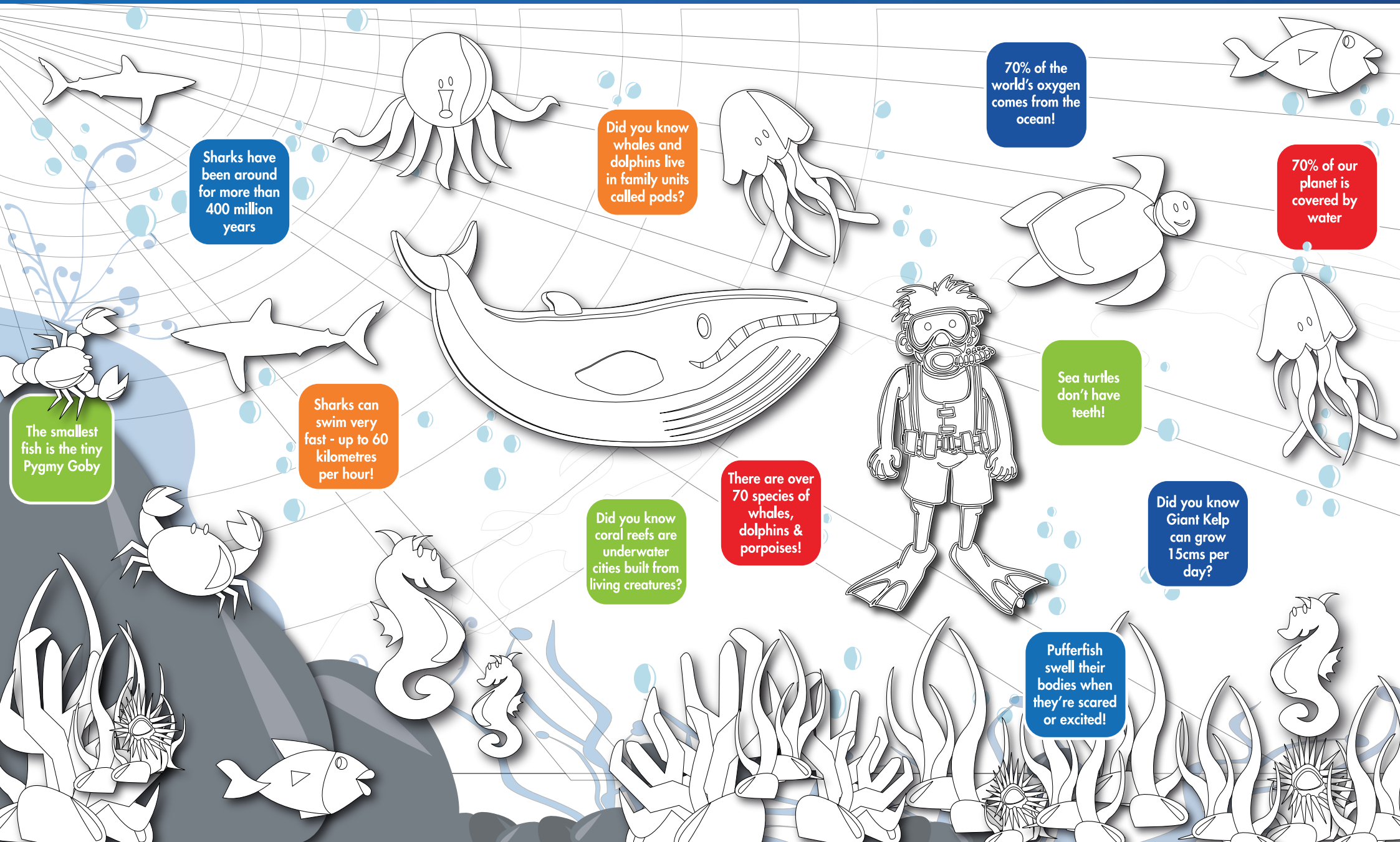
